



Cut on black lines, score and fold on gray lines. Assemble the body tube first; let the main tab dry before attempting to glue the nose flaps down. There is no score line for the nose flaps, and this is not an error... the nose flaps are intended to curve inward. Next, fold the "fin can" and glue the fins together. When the fins are dry (or at least set), slide the body tube up through the fin can from the bottom about halfway. Apply glue around the last half inch (13mm) or so of the body tube, and in one smooth quick motion slide the fin can down flush with the end of the body tube. Wipe off any excess glue. Last, fold the launch lug into shape, apply glue to the tabs and glue to the marked spot on the body tube. If you want a plain rocket, fold the parts inside out (but then you will have to position the launch lug without guidance).
